Information that we collect from you

When you use this site you may submit information to us, which is saved in your job wallet. We may also collect information about you from e-mails or letters you send to us and occasionally in feedback from employers.

Use of your information

We will hold your information securely and use it only in compliance with the applicable current data protection laws. We may also use and analyse the information we collect so that we can administer, support, improve and develop our business.

Disclosure of your information

The only parties to whom we may disclose your information are as follows:

- Those employers in respect of whom you have indicated, by pressing the "Apply Now" button on their job details, that you want to receive your details.
- Our employees who process the information for the purposes for which you have made it available to us and for the purposes of carrying out checks as to the quality of the service made available by the website.
- Our suppliers, advisers and auditors who may have incidental or necessary access to your information in the process of providing services to us, however they will be obliged to treat your information as confidential.

Unless required to do so by law, we will not otherwise share, sell or distribute any of the information you provide to us without your consent.

Transfers of Data
